- be proficient in English & maths: GCSE Grade C/4+ (or CEFR B2 if English is not your first language)

No prior teaching experience required, but established aesthetic practice expertise is essential.

How will I be assessed?

Continuous assessment throughout – there are no formal exams.

You will

- plan and deliver a 15-minute microteaching session
- complete written assignments
- keep a written record of your 30 hours of teaching practice
- keep a reflective account of your teaching practice
- be observed teaching by your assessor for a minimum of 3 hours across 3 sessions



Career opportunities

This qualification is suitable for teachers and trainers working across further education, vocational and skills settings, including work-based learning, academies and clinics.

It also supports a career pathway into assessment, internal quality assurance and higher-level teaching qualifications.
